

My name is Morgan Humphries and I am here to talk to about the new plan by Open Minds the plan is about ancient Greece and Rome the plan is written by myself as well as my colleague Chiara Mazza

Let's start with talking about the pack ... you receive

- the **detailed plan** obviously which is written in Italian. The plan includes the **instructions and video links that you will need**
- you will also receive the all of **the materials** that you require with the plan including all of the worksheets: there **are testing worksheets worksheets and the homework sheets**

I'll explain the details about the materials in the worksheets just a little bit later on in the video but for now let's start with the topic of the plan: it's based on **comparing modern-day life to the life of ancient Greece and Rome and making comparisons between the two worlds**

All of the information that you would need to know in English is written in **the powerpoints** which you receive with the plan: you can share this PowerPoint with your students during the lesson.

The PowerPoint is full of audio and pictures so it's very interactive and it's very easy way for your students to learn at the vocabulary in English.

Now I'm going to talk to about the materials so on top of the PowerPoint which you receive, you get the lesson plan and you also receive **interactive worksheets** which can be done during the lesson or as homework as well as these worksheets you will also receive **worksheets that are specifically focused on testing the students** so these testing worksheets are based on the **grammar** which is utilized during the lessons and lastly I'm going to show you a little preview of the plan

Here you can see an example of a lesson: in this case the topic is present simple and daily routines : you can see that it starts with revision about the previous topic then it outlines the exact slides that you need to speak about with the students in this case we are comparing modern-day daily routine with ancient Greece daily routine.

All of the lessons are based on very practical and useful topics such as daily routine, sports, food as well as the topics that the lessons are based on we have also integrated grammar topics for example wh-words the use of present simple and continuous, the verb to be and many more.

Highlighted in yellow you can find the testing worksheet which you can share with your students this can either be done during the lesson or as homework

In this case the testing worksheet is based on present simple and daily routines, following the explanation of the PowerPoint: there is usually **an interactive game** again highlighted in yellow which you can play with your students and this game will always be based on the topic of the lesson. Finally we have the explanation of the homework which usually revises what has been learned so during the lesson in this case the students are required to complete a comparison chart between

the daily routine follow the ancient Greece and the daily routine routine of modern day this is always designed to be a revision for the left.

As you can see **we have included plenty of materials and videos and games in this lesson plan** that so as well as being a very very practical way for the students to learn grammar it's also very enjoyable for the kids
